





San Francisco, March 4, 2020 - Spring is here and so are the tree and grass pollens that signal the start of allergy season. Major cities in Texas such as McAllen, El Paso, San Antonio, and metropolitan areas like Dallas and Austin are among the top U.S. cities with the highest pollen counts, making these regions particularly challenging for allergy sufferers.

According to the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America (AAFA) most seasonal spring allergies – known as hay fever or seasonal rhinitis - are caused by tree pollen as the trees bud and grow new leaves. Some of the most common Texas trees producing allergyaggravating pollen are cedar, birch, poplar, willow, aspen, and beech.
